CONDUCT & SECURITY PROCEDURES

ALL TAP ATTENDEES, PLAYERS, LICENSEES, STAFF – TAP’S Founder, Loyd Schonter, took great pride in providing to you the TAP Player, a Traveling Nationals. His Vision was to take TAP Players to places they may not have gotten a chance to go. He took great pride in selling his company and brand to the hotels as the Rolls Royce League. Sportsmanship and Conduct was, is and always will be the TOP PRIORITY. We remind the TAP Players, your conduct at these resorts and locations is only reflective of yourself, your team, your local operator’s territory, but also of the TAP Brand and the Schonter Family. With that in mind, we share with you the National Event Conduct & Security Procedures for ALL Rally Dream Team and Nationals Events.

- 1) **NO OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE** Can be brought into the event centers where the tables and play areas, events are held. If you are caught we can remove you from all events.
- 2) **Teams are reminded to monitor their own team.** No one else knows the 8 people on your team better than each other. If one of your players is out of line, tell them so. You take care of each other so the TAP Staff does not have to get involved.
- 3) **Anyone doing any damage to the hotel or any property of the hotel will incur the expense of paying the bill for that damage.** The Event Director, Kelly Nace will be notified by the hotel and or the TAP National Staff. At that time, coordination of the immediate removal from the events will occur, forfeit of any matches and or prize money if applicable. IF the hotel wants to press charges they have full right to do so. TAP Corporate, the Event Director and the Hotel will take any and all action they feel necessary in order to handle each situation that may arise. NOTE If hotel security has to take action, they will notify the Event Director and action will still take place, even if it was from the evening prior when TAP staff is not in attendance i.e. late night activity.
- 4) Anyone removed from an event due to damages to any property of the hotel, bathrooms, equipment, walls, table cloths etc. will not only be removed but will be **banned from all TAP National Events for 1 year.**
- 5) **No loud, vulgar actions will be tolerated especially in the hotel lobbies and common areas, where other guests are disturbed.** If the hotel kicks you off the property, you will be removed from the event and again banned for 1 year.
- 6) **The hotels and resorts will be notifying and reporting all conduct violations and problems to our Event Director, Kelly Nace.** She will take appropriate action and file reports to the TAP Corporate office. If the police are called, action will be taken by corporate as they see fit.
- 7) **Under 21 players and attendees,** must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times. They must have a wrist band on them at all times. Licensees should report to Kelly all players’ names that are under 21. She will have the TAP Registration Desk give them wrist bands daily. Make sure they check in daily. If any under 21 player attempts to obtain or consume alcohol, they will be removed from the event. Banned from TAP National Events and will be recommended that the licensee remove them from their league for 1 year as well. Those having family and friends at events that are non TAP members will be responsible for those non TAP Players. If they do not act according to our rules, the TAP Member they are at the event for will be held responsible for them.
- 8) **HOTEL LIQUOR LAWS VARY FROM STATE TO STATE. WE ABIDE BY THEIR RULES, NOT THE OTHER WAY AROUND.**
- 9) Everyone must be out of the Ballroom, playing area, by 3:00 AM and locked down and secured. Last Call for Alcohol will be done at each event and times may vary according to what that hotel wants or needs them to be.
- 10) Dress Code is quite simple, dress appropriately. No other league apparel, or you will be asked to change. No revealing clothing, or you will be asked to change. Those that do not want to comply will be asked to leave.

Overall, we expect the TAP Players to be on their best behavior, not only with the TAP Staff, Licensees, and Corporate office but also to the hotel, their staff, their hotel policies, the local and state laws that the events are held in. Worst case scenario, the hotel can shut down this event for multiple violations. Obviously, that is not an option. So please act accordingly and be respectful of your TAP National event, the host location, each other and mainly for yourself. We will enforce it, quickly and accordingly.
